Dear Principal

I refer to the Department led programme of detailed assessments carried out in 17 schools constructed by Western Building Systems during the summer months, which included Luttrellstown Community College. This programme was supported by the National Development Finance Agency and by ARUP and PUNCH engineering companies.

You will be aware that, following the detailed investigations in the 17 schools involved, the Department's engineers have advised that some permanent remediation work is required in each of the schools.

In the interim, some temporary engineering solutions have been or are being put in place in some parts of these school buildings.

These interim works were recently completed in Luttrellstown Community College with the building handed back to the school authority on the 22nd of August 2019.

The purpose of this letter is to confirm that the Department is satisfied that the works carried out in your school were completed to the required standard and that the building is safe to occupy.

The Department would like to express its sincere appreciation for your cooperation and to acknowledge the disruption and inconvenience caused to your school during this process. I would like to assure the Board of Management that the safety of pupils and staff has been and will continue to be our overriding priority and that this underpins all of our decisions.
